

# Earl Edgar Recreation Facility

Buckeye, AZ



The Earl Edgar Recreation Facility is an existing public park located at the northeast corner of Miller Road (1st Street) and Irwin Avenue (Beloat Road) in Buckeye, Arizona. This approximately 21-acre site is owned and maintained by the Town of Buckeye Parks Department. Premier provided civil engineering and survey services to renovate the park's facilities with a multi-use perimeter path, maintenance yard/building, concrete basketball courts, a batting cage and shade ramadas. In addition, the improvements included constructing a booster pump station at the wastewater treatment plant and approximately 3,150-feet of 12-inch effluent water main line from the plant to the park.

Premier's services included topographic survey, grading and drainage plans, on-site water, sewer and fire line plans, storm-water management plans, design reports for drainage, and water and sewer improvements. Premier also prepared the Effluent Water Line Plans (plan and profile) and Effluent Water Line Design Report in accordance with Town of Buckeye and Maricopa County standards.
